THE NATIONAL SOCIETY OF THE COLONIAL DAMES OF AMERICA CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, History shows that the remembrance of a nation's glory in the past stimulates to national greatness in the future, and that successive generations are awakened to truer patriotism and aroused to noble endeavor by the contemplation of the heroic deeds of their forefathers; therefore, The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America has been formed, that the descendants of those men, who in the Colonial period by their rectitude, courage, and self-denial prepared the way for success in that struggle which gained for the country its liberty and Constitution, may associate themselves together to honor the virtues of their forefathers, and to encourage in all who come under their influence, true patriotism built on a knowledge of the self-sacrifice and heroism of those men of the colonies who laid the foundation of this great nation.

ARTICLE I

Title

1. NAME AND ORGANIZATION. This Society shall be known by the name, style, and title of The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America, and shall be composed of Corporate Societies of which there are: the Societies in the Thirteen Colonial States, or the Colonial State Societies; the Society in the District of Columbia, or the Domicile or Charter Society; the Societies in the Non-Colonial States, or the Associate State Societies; and the Committees of Members in Territories and Foreign Countries. Every member of every State Society shall be a Dame of one of the Thirteen Colonial State Societies.

ARTICLE II Objects

1. The objects of this Society shall be to collect and preserve manuscripts, traditions, relics, and mementos of bygone days; to preserve and restore buildings connected with the early history of our country; to educate our fellow citizens and ourselves in our country's history and thus diffuse healthful and intelligent information concerning the past; to create a popular interest in our Colonial history; to stimulate a spirit of true patriotism and a genuine love of country; and to impress upon the young the sacred obligation of honoring the memory of those heroic ancestors whose ability, valor, sufferings, and achievements are beyond all praise.

ARTICLE III

Eligibility of Members

1. MEMBERSHIP. The Corporate Societies shall be composed entirely of women who are descended in their own right from some ancestor of worthy life who, residing in an American colony rendered efficient service

to his country during the Colonial period, either in the founding of a State or Commonwealth, or of an institution which has survived and developed into importance, or who shall have held an important position in a Colonial government, or who by distinguished services, shall have contributed to the founding of our nation.

2. DATE OF ANCESTOR'S SERVICES. All services which constitute a claim to membership must have been rendered before July 5, 1776, but this date shall be held to include all signers of the Declaration of Independence.

ARTICLE IV

Councils

- 1. MEETINGS. The regular meetings of The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America, hereafter referred to as Councils, shall be held every two years in the Washington, D.C. area. Special meetings may be held upon the order of the National President or upon a request of no fewer than eight of the original fourteen Societies, with the addition of a majority of the Associate State Societies.
- 2. MEMBERS. Such meetings shall consist of the National Officers and representatives from the Corporate Societies, as provided in the Covenant ratified at the Council of 1910.
- 3. METHODS OF VOTING. The vote of each of the original fourteen Societies (being the Societies in the Thirteen Colonial States and the Society in the District of Columbia) shall count as five and the vote of each of the Associate State Societies shall count as one.
- 4. EXPENSES. The necessary expense of such meetings shall be borne by the National Society.
- 5. OFFICERS. At the regular meeting of The National Society, a President, five Vice- Presidents, including one from each Region and a Vice President-Dumbarton House, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Registrar, and Historian shall be elected by ballot, a majority of the delegates elected or appointed to the Council being necessary to a choice. All officers shall serve until the next regular meeting or until their successors shall be chosen. The retiring President may be made an Honorary President after the installation of new officers. The nomination may be made and seconded from the floor and the vote shall be by voice.
- 6. ADMISSION OF SOCIETIES. The National Society shall have power at any meeting to admit a Corporate Society thereto from any State in the Union and from the District of Columbia, provided such State or District is not already represented in the National Society.
- 7. QUORUM. A majority of the delegates elected or appointed to the Council shall form a quorum.

ARTICLE V

Corporate Societies

- 1. MEETINGS. The Corporate Societies of The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America shall meet annually on the day appointed by their several bylaws, and more often if found expedient.
- 2. OFFICERS AND MANAGERS. The affairs of each Corporate Society shall be conducted by a Board, consisting of Officers and Managers. The Officers shall include a President, one or more Vice-Presidents, two Secretaries, a Treasurer, a Registrar, and a Historian. There shall be six or more Managers. The Officers and Managers shall be elected by ballot or voice vote by the members of the Corporate Society.
- 3. ELECTIONS. TERMS OF OFFICE. Each Officer shall be elected annually to serve a maximum of six consecutive years in one office. Each Society's Managers shall be elected to serve either a two or a three year term. Each Manager may serve up to six consecutive years. A Manager may be elected an Officer at any time. The Board shall fill its own vacancies with members chosen to serve until the next election. All officers shall hold office until their successors are elected.
- 4. MEMBERSHIP. The members of the Corporate Societies of The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America at the date of the certificate of incorporation of the Corporate Society shall be elected members of the corporation at the first meeting of the said Society subsequent to the incorporation, and thereafter no person shall be a candidate for admission unless invited and proposed by one member and seconded by another member of the Society, to both of whom the candidate must be well known, and by whom she shall be recommended. The Board of Managers of each Corporate Society may decide whether to accept a candidate proposed by a member of another Corporate Society.
- 5. ADMISSION OF MEMBERS. The President of each Society may appoint a Committee which shall consider the qualifications of each candidate and report to the President. When such reports are favorable, the name of the candidate shall be presented to the Board of Managers. The name of each candidate shall be voted upon separately by ballot according to the bylaws of that Society.
- 6. DUES. Each member shall contribute upon her admission to the Society, and annually thereafter, such sums as the bylaws of the respective Corporate Societies may require; but any Corporate Society may provide for the endowment of life-memberships by the payment of a proper sum.
- 7. AUTHORITY. The Corporate Societies shall regulate all matters respecting their own affairs, consistent with the general good of the Society; judge of the qualifications of their members, or of those proposed for membership, subject, however, to the provisions of this Constitution; and shall have the power to expel any member who, by conduct unbecoming

- a gentlewoman, may render herself unworthy to continue in membership.
- 8. REGISTRAR'S REPORT. The Registrar of each Corporate Society shall transmit to the National Registrar and to The National Society Office at Dumbarton House twice yearly a report of changes in membership. This is to include changes in name and address and the names of new members, transfers, and those who have died, resigned, or been dropped.
- 9. ANNUAL REPORTS. Each Corporate Society shall send annually to the other Corporate Societies and to the National Officers a report calling attention to whatever may be thought worthy of observation concerning the Society.
- 10. STATE SEALS. Each Corporate Society shall adopt its own seal.
- 11. CERTIFICATES. Each member of the Society is entitled, upon payment of a fee, to obtain a certificate of membership bearing the Seal of The National Society and signed by the National President.

ARTICLE VI

Badge and Seal

- 1. CUSTODIAN. The Custodian of the Insignia shall be the National Registrar, who shall issue permission to purchase a Badge to a member of a Corporate Society upon an order from the Registrar of that Society. She shall keep a register, wherein each Badge may be identified by the number assigned to the owner by her Corporate Society.
- 2. DESCRIPTION OF BADGE. The Badge shall consist of a round disc with a center of light blue enamel, and the figure of a Colonial Dame in gold modeled in relief on the same. Around the center of blue enamel shall be a circle of white enamel, with the title of the Society, "National Society of The Colonial Dames of America," in gold letters, flush. Surmounting this shall be the modeled figure of an eagle in gold, and diverging from the disc twenty rays in gold arranged in four groups of five each, the three center rays in each group to be summoned by stars of blue enamel, these, with a similar star placed immediately below the central disc being emblematic of the thirteen original states.
- 3. MOTTO AND MATERIAL. On the reverse side of the Badge shall be the motto, "Virtutes Majorum Filiae Conservant." The materials of the Badge shall be gold or silver gilt and enamel, and it shall be worn suspended by a silk ribbon of blue and yellow from a gold or silver gilt bar on which is the name of the member's Colonial State Society. The National President's Badge shall be suspended from a gold and enamel bar stating "President."
- 4. RIBBON. This ribbon shall be one and one-half inches wide, the central section of blue being one inch, with a section of yellow one-quarter of an inch wide on each side.

- 5. USE OF BADGE. This Badge shall be worn by the members on all occasions when they assemble officially for any stated purpose or celebration, and may be worn on any occasion of ceremony. It shall be carried conspicuously on the left breast, but members who are, or have been, national officers may wear it suspended from the ribbon around the neck. Members who are, or have been, Chairmen of the National Historical Activities Committee, the National Museum Properties Committee, or the National Patriotic Service Committee may wear it suspended from a small bow of ribbon. Members who have been, Chairman of the Dumbarton House Board, and members who are or have been First Regent of Gunston Hall, or the Senior Sulgrave Manor Representative may wear it suspended from a pleated bar. As a matter of respect, no pin or bar of identification shall be worn above the Badge.
- 6. SEAL. The seal of The National Society shall be: Within a beaded annulet an azure title scroll bearing the inscription in gold "National Society of The Colonial Dames of America." Within the scroll a shield, surmounted of the crown or, mantling gules doubled or, quarterly of four-I. Quarterly, one and four: azure, three fleurs-de-lis or; two and three: gules, three lions passant gardant in pale or (For England).
- II. Azure, three fleurs-de-lis or (for France).
- III. Azure billete or, a lion rampant or, crowned gules, holding in his dexter paw a naked sword and in his sinister paw a sheaf of arrows or (for Holland).
- IV.Quarterly, one and four: azure, three open crowns or (Sweden modern); two and three: azure, three bendlets sinister wavy argent, over all a lion rampant or, crowned gules (Sweden ancient).
- 7. USE OF SEAL. This seal is to be used on the certificate, for further authentication, and with it the signature of the National President.

ARTICLE VII

Amendments

This Constitution may be altered, added to, or amended by the vote of four-fifths of the delegates elected or appointed to the Council; but the unanimous consent of said Council shall be necessary to amend or repeal the conditions of admission into the Society, and the basis of representation in the National Councils set forth in the Covenant ratified at the Council of 1910, and stated in Article I and Article IV, paragraph 2, of this Constitution; or to adopt any amendments which shall interfere with the present status and rights of the original fourteen Societies; or to repeal paragraph 3 of Article IV. Due notice of an intention to amend any clause or article of this Constitution shall be given to each of the Corporate Societies one year before the meeting of the Council at which action is to be taken on such change, alteration, or amendment.

COVENANT

Between the Societies Constituting The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America

This Society is known by the name, style, and title of The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America, and is composed of Societies, of which there are at present, in the year 1908, thirty-six incorporated in accordance with the laws of their respective domiciles.

For the purpose of the perpetual maintenance and preservation of the Colonial character of the Society, it is mutually covenanted and agreed that every member of every Corporate Society shall be a Dame of one thirteen Colonial Societies.

For the further maintenance and preservation of the Colonial character of the Society, it is mutually covenanted and agreed that the number of delegates to the National Council from each of the Societies representing the Thirteen Colonies and from the Society in the District of Columbia (which is the domicile of The National Society) shall be to the number of delegates from the Societies now existing or hereafter to be formed in each of the other States, in the proportion of five to one.

This covenant shall not be added to, altered, or amended without the unanimous consent of the parties thereto; but further that as above expressed every delegate to the National Council shall have the right to vote upon the National Constitution and Bylaws and upon any and all questions which come before the Council

Bylaws

ARTICLE I

Name and Purpose

Section 1. Name. This organization is formed as a tax-exempt corporation under the laws of the State of Tennessee and shall be known as The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America in the State of Tennessee (hereinafter referred to as NSCDA-TN or the Tennessee Society).

Section 2. **Purpose and Objects.** The purpose and objects of this Society shall be those of The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America (hereinafter referred to as NSCDA). The Constitution and Acts in Council of the NSCDA shall be the supreme law of this society.

ARTICLE II

Headquarters and Office

The headquarters and registered office of the Society shall be **Travellers Rest Historic House Museum**, **636 Farrell Parkway**, **Nashville**, **and Davidson County**, **Tennessee 37220-1218**. The registered agent at that office shall be the President of the NSCDA-TN.

ARTICLE III

Insignia

Section 1. **Badge and Recognition Pin.** Refer to NSCDA Constitution, ARTICLE VI, Section 5 and Acts in Council, ARTICLE X, Sections 1 and 3.

Section 2. **Seal.** The seal was designed to suggest the ethnology and history of the people who originally settled and founded the State of Tennessee. The seal is an open Bible with a sword across the pages, surrounded by a wreath of Scotch thistle caught at the base with a spray of shamrock on which lies the harp of Erin, the whole encircled by the name The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America in Tennessee.

ARTICLE IV

Membership

Section 1. **Eligibility of Members.** The members of this Society shall consist of women who have been admitted in accordance with ARTICLE III of the NSCDA Constitution.

Section 2. Proposal of Candidates.

- a. Each year a member in good standing for one (1) year may propose or endorse candidates personally known to her. The proposer should first contact her respective Town Committee Registrar for procedures.
- b. A Dame may propose a direct descendent family member.
- Section 3. **Election of Candidates.** A candidate shall be elected upon approval of the Board of Town Committees and upon ratification by the Board of Managers.
- Section 4. **Acceptance as a Member.** Upon acceptance of her papers by the ancestral state and payment of dues and initiation fees, the candidate becomes a member.

Section 5. Categories of Members.

- a. Active. A member who has a right to full participation in the Society.
- b. Courtesy. A member who is recommended by her State Society may be extended Courtesy Membership for one year. She must ask the Board of Managers for renewal annually. Courtesy members can not hold office nor vote within the TN society.
- c. Emeritus. A member in good standing who is no longer able to participate due to infirmity or special circumstances may become an Emeritus Member. She would maintain all privileges of the Society except the vote. Board approval is required.
- Section 6. **Resignation.** A member wishing to resign must notify the Corresponding Secretary of her Town Committee in writing before October 1; otherwise she shall be held liable for dues for the ensuing year. State Corresponding Secretary will notify the State Registrar of resignations.
- Section 7. **Reinstatement.** A member who has resigned in good standing may be reinstated by the Board of Managers with a majority vote of those present and voting. A reinstatement fee of \$50 will be accessed.

Section 8. **Transfer.** A member may transfer from one State Society to the Tennessee Society. The Tennessee Society will recognize the Life Membership of a member transferring from another State Society.

ARTICLE V

Finances

Section 1. Dues and Fees.

- a. A new member shall pay the initiation fee required by the State Society through which she is admitted, the initiation fee and membership dues required by the Tennessee Society, and the NSCDA per capita dues.
- b. All other categories of members shall pay annually such dues and/ or fees as determined by the Board of Managers. A new member transferring to another society shall pay the initiation fee and the per capita fee of the Tennessee Society.
- c. A member who has paid all dues and/or fees is a member in good standing.
- Section 2. **Penalties.** A member in arrears for one fiscal year may be dropped from membership by a majority vote of the Board of Managers.
- Section 3. **Fiscal Year.** The fiscal year of the Tennessee Society shall be July 1st through June 30th.
- Section 4. Any monies donated to the TN Society shall be placed in the Projects Endowment Fund unless otherwise designated by the donor.

ARTICLE VI

Meetings of the Society

- Section 1. **Annual Meeting.** The Annual Meeting shall be held in Nashville at Travellers Rest in May on a date set by the President and approved by the Board of Managers.
- Section 2. **Board Visitation.** The Board of Managers shall visit with a town Committee each autumn, rotating those visits among the Town Committees.
- Section 3. **Special Meetings.** Special Meetings may be called at any time with at least three days notice by the President.
- Section 4. **Quorum.** Ten percent (10%) of all voting members of the Tennessee Society shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

8/31/17 By Laws NSCDA-TN 33

Section 5. **Voting.** All elections and all questions shall be decided by a majority of the quorum.

Section 6. **Notice.** Every member of the Society entitled to vote shall be given at least ten (10) days written notice of the place, date, hour, and description of any matter to be considered by the member at any regular meeting.

ARTICLE VII

Board of Managers

Section 1. **General Powers.** The Society shall be governed by a Board of Managers which shall have the general management and control of the business affairs of the NSCDA-TN. The Board of Managers shall exercise all powers that may be exercised or performed by the Society under the Constitution of the NSCDA, Acts in Council, the Charter of Incorporation, and these Bylaws. Members of the Board of Managers shall hold Active membership status.

Section 2. Officers.

- a. **The President** is a member of the Board of the NSCDA. She shall preside at all meetings of the NSCDA-TN, the Board of Managers and the Executive Committee. She shall have general supervision over the active management of the affairs of the Society subject to the will of the Board of Managers. She shall be an ex-officio voting member of all committees with the exception of the Nominating Committee. She is an ex-officio voting member of Travellers Rest Historic House Museum, Inc.
- b. **The First Vice President** shall assist the President and preside at all meetings in the absence of the President, and in the event of a vacancy in the office of President, shall exercise the functions of that office until it shall be filled by the Board of Managers.
- c. **The President Elect** shall serve on the Board of Managers the year prior to her serving as President.
- d. The Vice-Presidents of Town Committees shall be elected by said committees and then elected by the entire membership to serve as Vice-Presidents of the Board of Managers. Each Vice President shall serve as chairman of her Town Committee. She shall have general supervision over the active management of the affairs of her Town Committee subject to the will of the Board of Managers. She shall be an ex-officio member of all committees of the Town Committees with the exception of the Nominating and Admissions Committees.
- e. **The Recording Secretary** shall keep a record of the proceedings of the Society and of the Board of Managers.

- f. **The Corresponding Secretary** shall conduct the general correspondence of the Society and shall keep a record thereof. She shall take the place of the Recording Secretary in her absence.
- g. The Treasurer shall oversee the NSCDA-TN funds and securities and keep records of the Society's financial condition. She shall give reports at every Annual and Board of Manager's meeting reflecting the status of all the NSCDA-TN accounts and assets. She shall collect dues from the members, chair the Board of Managers' Finance Committee, pay out of the Society's funds such bills for the purposes of the Society as she shall be authorized to pay and have the Tennessee Society's accounts and assets reviewed or audited annually by a certified public accountant duly selected by the Board of Managers.
- h. **The Registrar** shall keep an account of the membership of the Tennessee Society. She shall coordinate all admissions procedures of the Tennessee Society. She shall be responsible for memorials for members of the Society.
- i. The Historian shall prepare an annual report of the Society's activities.

Section 3. Terms of Office.

- a. The President and Vice-Presidents shall be elected each year by the members of The Society. They shall serve no more than four (4) consecutive one-year terms.
- b. The Board of Managers elected at the Annual Meeting by members of the Society shall serve for a term of two (2) years beginning in June; the terms of one-half (1/2) of the Managers shall expire annually. A Manager shall be eligible to serve up to two (2) additional consecutive terms.
- c. A Manager whose third term has expired shall not be eligible for reelection as a Manager in that same position until the lapse of one year after her term expires. A manager shall not hold two positions on the Board simultaneously.
- d. The Board shall fill its own vacancies with members chosen to serve until the next election. All officers shall hold office until their successors are elected.
 - Section 4. **Meetings.** The Board of Managers shall meet a minimum of four (4) times a year. Special meetings may be called by the President or upon written request of three (3) members of the Board of Managers, with at least three days notice.

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Section 5. **Quorum for Board of Managers Meetings.** At all meetings of the Board of Managers, eleven (11) of the voting Managers shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The act of a majority of the Managers who are entitled to vote and are present at any meeting at which there is a quorum, shall constitute an act of said Board, except as otherwise provided by statute, Charter, or these Bylaws.

Section 6. Action Without Meeting. Action may be taken without a meeting if all Managers consent to taking such action. Once such unanimous consent has been obtained, the affirmative vote of the number of Managers that would be necessary to authorize or take such action at a meeting is an act of the Board of Managers. The action must be signed by each Manager, evidenced by one or more written assents describing the action taken, and included in the minutes filed in the NSCDA-TN records

Section 7. **Order of Business.** Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised shall guide the conduct of all business meetings of the Society, subject to the provisions of the National Constitution, Covenant, Acts in Council, Charter, or these Bylaws.

Lady of Dumbarton, responsible for the dissemination of information concerning Dumbarton House.

NSCDA-TN Historical Activites and Patriotic Service Fund Chariman, responsible for the dissemination of information concerning the NSCAD-TN Historical Activities and Patriotic Service Fund.

Regent of Gunston Hall, responsible for the dissemination of information concerning Gunston Hall.

- e. Non-voting members of the Board of Managers in addition to the above may be appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Managers.
- f. The Chairman of the Bylaws Committee shall also serve as Parliamentarian.
- g. National Officers, Honorary Presidents, Regional Chairmen, and District Chairmen may be invited to attend Board meetings as non-voting members.

Section 9. Nomination and Election of Managers.

- a. Proposed Managers shall be voted upon at the annual meeting from a slate of candidates published in the spring newsletter.
- b. The Chairman of the Nominating Committee shall present the slate at the Annual Meeting.
- Section 10. **Removal of Managers**. Any Manager may be removed with cause at any time by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership present at any Annual or Special Meeting of the NSCDA-TN provided membership has been notified of this intent three days ahead.
- Section 11. **Executive Committee**. The Executive Committee, consisting of the President, Vice-Presidents, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Registrar, and Historian shall have all the power of the Board of Managers between Board meetings. Five shall constitute a quorum. Any action taken by the Executive Committee will be reported at the next Board of Managers meeting for ratification.

Section 12. Town Committees.

- a. Town Committees may be formed at the discretion of the Board of Managers. Such Committees shall conduct their affairs in compliance with ARTICLE XIII, Section 2, of the NSCDA Acts in Council. Fifteen members are considered a minimum for a viable committee.
- b. Each Town Committee shall have a chairman elected by its respective membership, who will then be elected by the NSCDA-TN membership as a Vice-President of the Tennessee Society.

Section 13. Standing Committees.

- a. **Bylaws**. Shall study the Bylaws and Standing Rules annually and make recommendations of necessary changes to the Board of Managers.
- b. **Finance**. Chaired by the Treasurer. Shall review matters pertaining to the finances of the Tennessee Society and make recommendations to the Board of Managers.
- c. **Historical Activities**. Shall be responsible for activities of historical significance as stated in ARTICLE II of the NSCDA Constitution
- d. **Hospitality**. Shall be responsible for the arrangements of all Nashville area meetings of the Tennessee Society.
- e. **Museum Properties**. Chaired by the Travellers Rest Historic House Museum Properties Representative. Committee shall be responsible for programs outlined to support the museum's mission and activities, in accordance with agreements and leases with the NSCDA-TN. The Travellers Rest Historic House Museum, Inc., Board of Directors shall manage the museum properties and the funds accrued for its purposes.
- f. **Newsletter**. Shall be responsible for the publication and mailing of a newsletter to the membership.
- g. **Patriotic Service**. Shall be responsible for the promotion of patriotic activities as stated in ARTICLE II of the NSCDA Constitution.
- h. **Printing**. Shall be responsible for printing required by the Board of Managers.
- i. **Roster/Directory**. Shall keep current membership information and, at the request of the Board of Managers, shall have a Directory including the Roster printed and distributed to the membership.

Section 14. Special Committees.

- a. Advisory. Shall advise the Board of Managers.
- b. **Consultants**. Shall be called at the discretion of the President.
- c. **Nominating**. The Nominating Committee shall consist of five (5) members; the chairman appointed by the President and four (4) representing the four Town committees. The nominating committee shall be published in the Fall Newsletter. The chairman shall sit on the Board of Managers for one (1) year.

Long Range Planning. Shall be responsible for evaluating and advising long-range needs of the Tennessee Society for consideration by the Board of Managers. This committee shall be appointed at the discretion of the President.

ARTICLE VIII Liability of Managers

To the fullest extent permitted by the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act as in effect on the date hereof and as hereafter amended from time to time, a manager of the corporation shall not 8/31/17 By Laws

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be liable to the corporation or its members for monetary damages for their breach of fiduciary duty as a manager. If the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act or any successor statute is amended after adoption of this provision to authorize corporate action further eliminating or limiting the personal liability of managers, then the liability of a manager of the corporation shall be eliminated or limited to the fullest extent permitted by the Tennessee Nonprofit Corporation Act, as so amended from time to time. Any repeal of this Section shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a manager of the corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification or with respect to events occurring prior to such time.

ARTICLE IX Public Benefit

Section 1. The NSCDA-TN is a public benefit corporation, organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code. Any provisions of these by laws which would in any manner adversely affect the tax-exempt status of the Society shall be void and shall be deleted or modified as necessary to comply with all applicable requirements for the maintenance of the tax- exempt status of the Society.

Section 2. No member shall receive compensation from the Society for her services as Manager.

ARTICLE X Amendment of Bylaws

Section 1. These Bylaws may be amended after approval of the Board of Managers, by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting at any regular or special meeting, provided notice of the proposed amendment(s) is published in the newsletter.

Section 2. Suggestions from the membership for amendments to the Bylaws must be presented in writing to the Bylaw Committee by January 1 of each year.

ARTICLE XI

Dissolution of the Society according to NSCDA Acts of Council (Article XVIII, Sec.

Standing Rules

Membership

1. **Eligibility of Members**. Members shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age and current or former residents of Tennessee or a sister, mother, daughter or granddaughter of a current Tennessee Dame.

2. Proposal of Candidates

- a. A member in good standing shall obtain the proper form from the Registrar of her respective Town Committee.
- b. The completed forms shall be submitted to the Register of the Town Committee.
- c. A member from one Town Committee may propose or endorse a candidate living in the area of another said Committee so long as the other endorser is from that Town Committee.

3. Election of Candidates

- a. The Registrar shall examine the proposal papers of the proposed candidates and make any inquiries necessary concerning the eligibility of the candidates.
- b. The names of the candidates shall be presented to the Town Committee Board, in writing or email, prior to a vote.
- c. If a candidate receives 2 negative votes then she is not eligible for membership at this time. This will count against her future times of eligibility.
- d. The names of the candidates that have been approved by their respective Town Committee Boards shall be submitted to the State Registrar who will present the candidate to the State Board of Managers for ratification.
- e. A candidate may be proposed three (3) times.
- f. It is the responsibility of the State Registrar and the Registrars of the Town Committees to offer assistance to a candidate in completing her lineage papers.
- 4. **Lineage Papers.** On the death of a member, her lineage papers shall become the property of the Tennessee Society.

5. Courtesy Members.

- a. A member wishing to become a courtesy member in the Tennessee Society must notify the Registrar of her State Society who will make the written request.
- b. Upon recommendation of the Town Committee with which a member wishes to affiliate, Courtesy memberships may be presented for approval at any regular Board of Managers meeting.
- c. Request for renewal of Courtesy status must be made annually to the Board of Managers.
- d. Courtesy Members may not vote or hold office in the Tennessee Society.
- 6. **Emeritus Members**. A member may become an emeritus member upon recommendation by her Town Committee and the vote of the Board of Managers.
- 7. **Resigned in Good Standing**. A member's name remains on NSCDATN roll only. No dues are paid and there are no membership privileges given.

8. Transfer of Members.

a. A member wishing to transfer to the Tennessee Society must notify the Registrar of her State Society who will initiate the process of transfer.

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- Only members of one year or more and in good standing may transfer.
- c. No action shall be taken regarding transfers out of the Tennessee Society during the months of April, May, November, and December.
- d. Transfer of membership is to be reported at any regular Board of
- e. A copy of her papers must be sent by the Registrar of said State to the Tennessee Registrar before the transfer is finalized.
- 9. **Deceased members**. Deceased members are honored during the White Rose Ceremony at the Annual Meeting of the year in which they passed away. This includes emeritus members. The Board of Managers of a town committee may also request that the name of a member who resigned in good standing be included.

Finances

Dues and Fees

- a. National per capita dues are \$40.
- b. Active membership dues are \$80. \$25 of this amount is designated for Travellers Rest.
- c. New members admitted to the NSCDA-TN during the time period from July 1 through December 31 of a calendar year will be assessed the full dues amount of \$120. New members admitted in the time period from January 1 through June 30 will pay a prorated amount for their dues based on the number of months of membership. A one-time initiation fee of \$50 and a scanning fee of \$10 will be added to all new member dues.
- d. Courtesy membership dues are \$35.
- e. Life member pays the NSCDA-TN per capita dues and a NSCDA-TN TN mailing fee of \$10.
- f. Emeritus members pay the NSCDA-TN per capita dues and NSCDA-TN mailing fee of \$10. Optionally, they may pay the current Travellers Rest membership fee.
- g. Dues are payable upon receipt (July 1) of dues notice.
- h. Dues will be late after November 1.
- i. There will be a fine of \$25 on late dues.
- j. Reinstatement fee is \$50.
- k. There is a refund to each Town Committee of \$8 for each Active or Courtesy member of that committee.

5. **Recording Secretary**

- a. File copies of all Minutes at the NSCDA-TN Headquarters.
- b. Send minutes of Board Meetings and notices of the next Board Meeting.

6. Corresponding Secretary

Handles Society correspondence.

7. Treasurer

- a. May appoint an Assistant(s) as needed with the approval of the Board of Managers.
- b. Chair the Finance Committee. Finance Committee shall consist of the President, President-Elect, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, First Vice-President, past NSCDA-TN Treasurer, Museum Properties Representative, Project Endowment Chairman, and at least two (@) members-at-large of the NSCDA-TN.
- c. Receive memorials designated for a specific purpose and notify corresponding secretary for acknowledgement.
- d. Attend Biennial Council Meetings and Region III Conferences or send a representative.

- e. Serve on the Travellers Rest Finance Committee.
- f. Serve on the NSCDA-TN Projects Endowment Fund Committee.

8. Registrar

- a. Keep proper custody of all lineage papers. The papers shall not be available to anyone without written permission of the owner during her lifetime.
- b. Keep a register recording the names of each member elected to the NSCDA-TN, the number of her paper, and the names of her proposer, endorser, and ancestor(s) who have rendered her eligible.
- c. Notify a candidate of her election and send proposal form to her Ancestral State. Assist in the preparation of the candidate's lineage papers and forward them, duly signed, to the Registrar of her Ancestral State.
- d. Notify all applicants of the eligibility of their ancestor(s) and the proof of descent from them. Notify the Treasurer when a candidate has been accepted by her Ancestral State Society.

15. Patriotic Service Chairman

- a. Appoint Patriotic Service Committee with the President and with the approval of the Board of Managers, with the exception of those members appointed by Town Committee Vice-Presidents.
- b. Have responsibility for the Parade of Flags.
- c. Attend Biennial Council Meetings and Region III Conferences or send a representative.

16. NSCDA/TÑ Projects Endowment Fund Chairman

- a. Appoints the Projects Endowment Fund Committee with the President and with the approval of the Board of Managers, with the exception of those members appointed by Town Committee Chairmen.
- b. Convene the Fund Committee as mandated or needed.
- c. Oversee the management of the NSCDA/TN Projects Endowment Fund.
- d. At the death of a past President, send monetary donation to the NSCDA-TN Projects Endowment Fund in her memory in the amount authorized by the Board of Managers.

20. Associate Trustee of Friends of Sulgrave Manor

Serve on the National Committee of Friends of Sulgrave Manor for a term of two (2) years. She is eligible to be appointed for two (2) additional terms for a total of six (6) years.

Special Committees

1. Advisory Committee

Consists of up to six (6) community leaders, the President, the Treasurer, and Board members involved in a particular project. Advisory Committee is appointed by the President with the approval of the Board of Managers when needed for a particular project.

2. Consultants

Consists of all former Presidents and meets at the discretion of the President to advise her.

3. Nominating Committee

The Nominating Committee of the NSCDA-TN consists of (5) five members; (1) one from each of the Town Committees, and a chairman appointed by the president.

4. Long Range Planning Chairman

- a. Chair the Long Range Planning Committee, the majority of which shall consist of past members of the Board of Managers.
- b. Plan and chair meetings when necessary.
- c. Present recommendations to the Board of Managers for consideration.

Amendment of Standing Rules

Treasurer's Report

Audited financial statements for the fiscal year ended June 30^{th} 2017, presented by the certified public accounting firm of Byrd, Proctor & Mills, P.C. may be obtained upon request from the Treasurer before the end of the calendar year.

Summary of Significant Accounting Policies: in 1954, the national Society of The Colonial Dames of America in the State of Tennessee (the Society) received as a gift the Historic Travellers Rest site. The deed to the property contains a provision that the property must be maintained exclusively as a historic shrine or title will revert to the owner. In 1988, the Society voted to establish a separate corporation named Travellers Rest Historic House Museum, Inc. The Museum leases the Travellers Rest site from the Society for one dollar a year for 99 years. The lease also requires that the property be maintained as a historic shire. Because the property is leased to Travellers Rest Historic House Museum, Inc. for 99 years at such a nominal rental and due to the possibility of reversion to the original donor, it is not reflected on the financial statements of the Society.

In 1964, the Society established a trust fund called The National Society of the Colonial Dames of America in Tennessee Foundation for Travellers Rest (the Foundation). Assets of the Foundation are restricted for maintenance, repair, upkeep and improvement of the Travellers Rest site. Although the Society's authorization is required for all expenditures from the Foundation, they have delegated this authority to the Museum. The accounts of the Foundation are not included in the financial statements of the Society, but are available for review from the Treasurer.

NSCDA –TN Historian's Report 2016-2017

The National Society of The Colonial Dames of America in the State of Tennessee sends warmest regards to all of the officers of our national and state societies.

This year we welcomed the leadership of our enthusiastic new president, Anne Guerra, Mrs. Anthony Robert Guerra. Under her guidance and with her dedication, energy, and hard work we have enjoyed a very busy and productive year.

This past September a Naturalization Ceremony was hosted at Travellers Rest. It was wonderful to have this take place at our historic property and especially exciting to welcome new Americans at Judge John Overton's Home. Fifty new citizens and their guests received flag pins, enjoyed refreshments, and entertainment.

September 14th, the NSCDA –TN Board of Managers dinner was held with members of the Nashville Town Committee, followed by a meeting the next day. Also in September under the direction of Matte Campbell, The Oak Hill School was treated to a morning of inter-active performances as students shared role playing in skits comparing the life styles and manners of Colonial Americans with present day practices as part of the curriculum for "Why America is Free." In October several Dames enjoyed the opportunity to attend the NSCDA Biennial in Arlington Virginia.

We are proud to announce that an intensive study of how to best manage and increase the Project Endowment Fund has now been completed. The study began in October 2015 and after diligent work and research by the committee, we are excited to announce that one hundred percent of the State Board Members have supported the move of the investment vehicle, and the name change from Projects Endowment Fund to Historical Activities and Patriotic Service Fund. The name change required a change in the By Laws that was voted on and approved by the Membership at the Annual Meeting in May 2017. The Annual Meeting on Thursday, May 4, provided an opportunity to celebrate the women who had the original vision, and took the first steps to create the Projects Endowment Fund.

The Annual NSCDA-TN dinner, held on May 3rd, began with cocktails on the lower gallery of Travellers Rest, followed by dinner in the barn. It was enjoyed by everyone in attendance. The Annual meeting on May 4th was also held at Travellers Rest. We heard reports from the officers, and committees. The new slate of officers was announced, and the town committee chairmen honored the memories of deceased members with the White Rose Ceremony. The meeting also celebrated the remarkable women who had the forethought to create the Projects Endowment Fund.

The President's Report concluded with an informative and compelling presentation. President Anne Guerra asked the Board Members for information and personal tales about their qualifying ancestors for Colonial Dames membership. The stories she told were both touching and inspiring, and we were all left with renewed respect for our great

countrymen and the sacrifices they made for our freedom. The meeting was adjourned and followed by a picnic lunch served in the barn.

Our Tennessee Museum Properties Chairman, Ann Kelly reports that this year has seen a steady stream of school groups visiting, not only for Trade Days and Plantation Holidays, but also for individual programs. Including all of these programs and special events, approximately 12,500 students have had an opportunity to visit Travellers Rest this year. Travellers Rest also hosted a workshop for ALHFAM, an organization of re-enactors, and museum professionals involved in Living History programs. In January the Dames hosted a luncheon for the Travellers Rest staff to say "thank you." There are plans to make this an annual tradition. In addition, much needed structural work has happened on site this year made possible with funds awarded in a one time grant by the Tennessee Historic Commission.

The Lady of Dumbarton House, Susan Brackney, reports that Dumbarton is back "home" after being out of the house for six months. Because of updates being done, over 4000 objects had been removed from the house. They are now back in place with an official opening June 1st and exciting plans for the future.

Penn Grove, our Tennessee Regent of Gunston Hall, reports that many events besides daily activities have been popular this year including Annual Kite Flying Day, Archeology Day, Christmastide at Gunston Hall, Cocktails by Candlelight, Revolutionary War Day, and Declaration Day. A decorative art symposium and an archeological symposium were also held on site.

Betty Barton Blythe reports that Friends of Sulgrave Manor are planning a trip to Sulgrave, England in 2018. The Tennessee Dames made a generous contribution to help cover costs associated with water damage and beetle issues. This also includes work being completed to provide climate-controlled space to store archives.

These three historic properties are important parts of our nation's history, and the work to keep them preserved requires constant attention. The generous donations and support from the Tennessee Dames is invaluable in this important endeavor.

The Dames Town Committees have all been very productive and active this year in support of educational and historical activities.

The Chattanooga Dames have had an exciting year hosting their first meeting in September at the historical McCoy House. In October the Dames attended an Eagle Scout Project Presentation at the Houston Museum of Decorative Arts. In November they toured the Medal of Honor Museum. The Winter Cocktail Buffet was held at Walden Club in February, where guests enjoyed the panoramic views while catching up with friends. The Dames volunteered at the Houston Museum Antiques Show, also held in February. The March meeting included a tour of the International Towing and Recovery Museum, celebrating the 100th anniversary of the tow truck, which was first built in

Chattanooga. The May meeting was held at the Reflection Riding Arboretum and Nature Center, where Dames were treated to electric tram tours.

The Knoxville Town Committee enjoyed four lunch programs this year all with interesting speakers. The first speaker presented little known facts about Captain John Smith. Following that, the next program topic was The Sequoyah Birthplace Museum in Vonore, Tennessee. In March the Dames learned about marble mined in East Tennessee. Travellers Rest, begun in 1799, was constructed as the home of Judge John Overton and his family; it remained so for almost 150 years. Now it is Nashville's oldest historic house open to the public.
